FIRST ORDINANCE AMENDING THE JAY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDINANCE

The Jay Administrative Ordinance, enacted on January 21, 2003, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. Deletions to the Administrative Ordinance, enacted January 21, 2003, are shown by a line through the deleted language. Additions to the Administrative Ordinance, enacted January 21, 2003, are shown by underlining of the added language.

Section 2. Section 2.4 is hereby deleted in its entirety:

~~The Town of Jay property taxes are due and payable on October 1 and April 1 of each year. The Town of Jay levies interest on property taxes that are unpaid after October 1 and April 1 of each year. The interest shall accrue at the maximum rate as determined by the Treasurer of the State of Maine for delinquent taxes pursuant to 36 M.R.S.A., Section 505.~~

~~The Town of Jay shall pay to taxpayers as interest on tax payments made in excess of the amount assessed as due and payable. This interest rate shall be 4% lower than the rate as determined by the Treasurer of the State of Maine for delinquent taxes and as provided in 36 M.R.S.A., Section 506-A and as the state is amended from time to time.~~
