

WARRANT FOR TOWN MEETING

TO: RICHARD CATON, A CONSTABLE IN THE TOWN OF JAY, COUNTY OF FRANKLIN, STATE OF MAINE:

In the name of the State of Maine, County of Franklin, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Jay, in said County, qualified to vote in Town affairs, to meet in the Spruce Mountain Middle School Cafeteria, in said Town, on Monday, the 24th day of June A.D. 2019 at 6:00 P.M. in the evening, then and there to act on the following articles to wit:

ARTICLE 1

To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.

ARTICLE 2


To see if the Town will vote to oppose the Central Maine Power (CMP) New England Clean Energy Connect (NECEC) 145 Mile Hydro-electric Transmission Line Project from Quebec border through the State of Maine.

ARTICLE 3

To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to submit a letter of opposition to: Central Maine Power (CMP) New England Clean Energy Connect (NECEC), Maine Public Utilities Commission, Maine Department of Environmental Protection, and Maine Land Use Planning Commission; on behalf of the Inhabitants of the Town of Jay in the event that Article #2 is passed with a YES vote.
