TO: Larry White, Constable of Jay: You are hereby required in the name of the State of Maine to notify the voters of the Town of Jay of the town meeting secret ballot election described in this warrant.

TO THE VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF JAY:

You are hereby notified that a Town Meeting Secret Ballot Election will be held at 9:00 A.M. on April 19, 2011 at the Jay Town Office, 340 Main Street for the purpose of determining the following articles:

Article 1: To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.

Article 2: To elect six (6) directors to the initial school board of Regional School Unit No. 73, who shall determine their terms of office by drawing lots pursuant to section 1472-B of Title 20-A of the Maine Revised Statutes, as amended.

The voting on Article 2 shall be by secret ballot election. The polls will be opened immediately after the election of the Moderator following commencement of the meeting at 9:00 A.M. and closed at 8:00 P.M.

The Registrar of Voters will hold office hours while the polls are open to correct any error in or change a name or address on the voting list; to accept the registration of any person eligible to vote and to accept new enrollments.

A person who is not registered as a voter may not vote in any election.
