WARRANT FOR TOWN MEETING

TO: LARRY WHITE, A CONSTABLE IN THE TOWN OF JAY, COUNTY OF FRANKLIN, STATE OF MAINE:

In the name of the State of Maine, County of Franklin, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Jay, in said County, qualified to vote in Town affairs, to meet in the Jay Municipal Building, in said Town, on Tuesday, the 11th day of June A.D. 2013 at 8:00 A.M. in the forenoon, then and there to act on the following articles to wit:

To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.

To choose by ballot the following Town Officers, for the ensuing year in accordance with Title 30-A Section 2528, of the Revised Statutes of Maine for the year 1964 and amendments thereto, to wit: One Selectperson, Assessor, and Overseer of the Poor, Third for three years; and Two Members of the School Board, for three years:

To vote by ballot the following warrant articles for the ensuing year in accordance with Title 30-A Section 2528, of the Revised Statutes of Maine for the year 1964 and amendments thereto.

ARTICLE 3

To see if the Town will vote to lapse the overdrafts and unexpended balances?
