

WARRANT FOR TOWN MEETING

TO: LARRY WHITE, A CONSTABLE IN THE TOWN OF JAY, COUNTY OF FRANKLIN, STATE OF MAINE:

In the name of the State of Maine, County of Franklin, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Jay, in said County, qualified to vote in Town affairs, to meet in the Jay Community Building, in said Town, on Tuesday, the 14th day of June A.D. 2011 at 9:00 A.M. in the forenoon, then and there to act on the following articles to wit:

ARTICLE 1

To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.

ARTICLE 2

To choose by ballot the following Town Officers, for the ensuing year in accordance with Title 30-A Section 2528, of the Revised Statutes of Maine for the year 1964 and amendments thereto, to wit: Two Selectman, Assessors, and Overseers of the Poor, Fourth and Fifth for three years:

To vote by ballot the following warrant articles for the ensuing year in accordance with Title 30-A Section 2528, of the Revised Statutes of Maine for the year 1964 and amendments thereto.

ARTICLE 3

To see if the Town will vote to lapse the overdrafts and unexpended balances?

ARTICLE 4

To see if the Town will vote to set October 3, 2011 and April 2, 2012 as the date that property taxes are due and payable?

ARTICLE 5

To see if the Town will vote to levy and accrue interest at the rate of seven percent (7%) per annum on property taxes that are unpaid after October 3, 2011 and April 2, 2012?

ARTICLE 6

To see if the Town will vote to authorize the municipal officers to spend an amount not to exceed 3/12 of the budgeted amount in each budget category of last years annual budget during the period from July 1, 2011 to October 1, 2011 or until a budget is passed for the 2011-2012 year in the event any budget fails?
